INTEGRATED PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT

In parents life a child is the most ambitious dream. The entire future of an individual, the family and the society depends upon a child's growth and development. The formal education at SGBMS aims at balanced development of a student's academic, mental, physical, cultural, emotional and spiritual faculties. Besides imparting theoretical education, the school takes special care to mould human character. SGBMS provides opportunities to learn Yoga & Meditation to reinforce the innerself of every child. SGBMS helps the child to grow into a balanced person and to realize his true potential in a caring and sensitive learning environment. APPLICATION OF NEW TECHNIQUE OF EDUCATION

EVALUATION AND GRADING

STAFF

The School Management has taken special care in the recruitment of teachers having excellent academic background with benevolent disposition towards children.

ACADEMIC SESSION

Academic Session of the school is from 1st April to 31 March. The School conducts two terminal examinations (Term-I & Term-II) in September and in February/March. Apart from these students will have regular class tests and written tests in all subjects on the basis of which the progress of the child will be assessed and will be taken into consideration for promotion of the students.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Parents seeking admission for their wards should obtain an application for registration and school prospectus from school office. There will be an interview of children for admission in Nursery for other classes the children will be selected on the basis of written test and interview. Dates for issuing application form and test is displayed on School Notice Board and is published in the local newspapers.

The School functions for Six days in a week with last Saturday and Sundays as holidays.

FEE REGULATION

1. The school fee will be collected at the school office on all working days. Timing - 9 A.M. to 1 P.M.
2. The tuition fee and bus fee are to be paid for 12 months.
3. Fee can be deposited in advance for any number of months or for the full session if so desired.
4. Parents may kindly keep the fee deposit receipts in safe custody and produce these to the school in proof of their payment, if required.
5. Fee will be received only on producing the Fee Card.
6. All dues should be cleared before the commencement of each examination or else he/she will not be allowed to sit for the examination.
7. If a student wants to discontinue the bus service he/she must inform the office one month in advance and submit the bus pass in our office. The discontinuous of bus services will not be granted from Oct. onwards.
 - (a) The fees should be deposited by 15th of each month.
 - (b) A late fine of Rs. 10/- (per day) will be charged after 15th of the same month.
2. Fees for **April and May** is to be deposited in the **Month of April**.
3. Fees for **Feb. and March** is to be deposited before **15th February**.

TRANSPORT FACILITY

Transport facility is available at reasonable charges for all important routes of the city; and stoppages have been decided as per the convenience of students availing the bus service.

WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

A request for withdrawal of student must be made in writing a month in advance to the School Authority before a child is expected to be withdrawn failing which Rs. 300.00 will be charged along with the tuition fee till the month in which the student is leaving.
